

# Contest Rules

NO PURCHASE IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. A PURCHASE WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING. ALL FEDERAL, STATE, LOCAL AND MUNICIPAL LAWS AND REGULATIONS APPLY. VOID WHERE PROHIBITED.

## 1) Eligibility

EPISCOPAL DESIGN CONTEST (“Contest”) is open to legal residents of the 50 United States and the District of Columbia who are at least 18 years old at the time of entry. Employees of Terra Sancta Guild and other companies associated with the promotion of EPISCOPAL DESIGN CONTEST, and their respective parents, subsidiaries, affiliates and advertising and promotion agencies as well as immediate family (spouse, parents, siblings and children) and household members of each such employee are not eligible. The contest is subject to federal, state and local laws and regulations.

## 2) Sponsor

The contest is sponsored by Terra Sancta Guild.

## 3) Agreement to Official Rules

Participation in the Contest constitutes entrants full and unconditional agreement to and acceptance of these Official Rules and the decision of the sponsor, which are final and binding. ## 6) Potential Winners

On or about October 15, 2011, the Sponsor will select **10 potential winners** in an art judging contest from among the eligible entries received. The odds of being selected will depend on the number of entries received. The Sponsor will attempt to notify the potential winners via telephone or email on or about October 22, 2011. If the potential winners cannot be contacted within 5 days after the date of the first attempt to contact him/her, the Sponsor may select an alternate potential winners in his/her place from the remaining non-winning, eligible entries.

## 7) Winner Notification:

The potential winners will be notified by email, mail or phone. Each potential winner (parent/legal Guardian if a minor in his/her state of residence) will be required to complete, electronically sign and submit a Declaration of Compliance within 5 days of the date notice or attempted notice is sent, in order to claim his/her prize. If a potential winner cannot be contacted, or fails to submit the Declaration of Compliance within the required time period, or prize is returned as undeliverable, potential winner forfeits prize. If potential winner is at least 18 years but still considered a minor in his/her jurisdiction of residence, Sponsor reserves the right to award the prize in the name of his/her parent or legal guardian, who will be required to sign the declaration of compliance on the potential winners behalf and fulfill any other requirements imposed on winner set forth herein. Potential winners must continue to comply with all terms and conditions of these Official Rules, and winning is contingent upon fulfilling all requirements. In the event that a potential winner is disqualified for any reason, Sponsor will award the applicable prize to an alternate winner from among all remaining eligible entries. Only 3 alternate drawings will be held, after which the prize will remain un-awarded. Prize will be fulfilled approximately 8-10 weeks after the conclusion of the Contest.

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## 8) Winner Selection:

Once potential winners have completed all required steps, Sponsor will post artwork on Facebook Fan Page for public voting to narrow down **top 3 designs**.

With the top 3 selections chosen by fans, Sponsor will have 3 local Episcopal Pastors vote on the best design.

## 10) General Conditions

In the event that the operation, security or administration of the contest is impaired in anyway for any reason, including, but not limited to fraud, virus, bug, worm, unauthorized human intervention or other technical problem, or in the event the Contest is unable to run as planned for any other reason, as determined by the Sponsor in its sole discretion, the Sponsor may, in its sole discretion, either

- a) Suspend the Contest to address the impairment and then resume the Contest in a manner that best conforms to the spirit of these office rules
- b) Terminate the Contest and, in the event of termination, award the prize at random from among the eligible, non-suspect entries received up to time of impairment.

The Sponsor reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual it finds to be tampering with the entry process or the operation of the Contest or to be acting in violation of these Official Rules or in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner. Any attempt by any person to damage the website or undermine the legitimate operation of the Contest may be a violation of criminal or civic law, and, should such an attempt be made, the Sponsor reserves the right to seek damages (including attorneys fees) and any other remedies from any such person to the fullest extent permitted by law. Failure by the Sponsor to enforce any provision of these Official Rules shall not constitute a waiver of that provision.

## 11) Release and Limitations of Liability

By participating in the Contest, entrants agree to release and hold harmless the Sponsor, and each of their respective parents, subsidiaries, affiliates, advertising and promotion agencies, other companies associated with the Contest and each of their respective officers, directors, employees, shareholders, representatives and agents (the Released Parties) from and against any claim or cause of action arising out of participation in the Contest or receipt or use of the prize (including any travel or activity related thereto), including, but not limited to:

- a) Any technical errors associated with the Contest, including lost, interrupted or unavailable Internet Service Provider (ISP), network, server, wireless service provider, or other connections, availability or accessibility or miscommunications or failed computer, satellite, telephone, cellular tower or cable transmission, lines or technical failure or jumbled, scrambled, delayed or misdirected transmissions or computer hardware or software malfunctions, failures or difficulties

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- b) Unauthorized human intervention in the Contest
- c) Mechanical, network, electronic, computer, human, printing or typographical errors
- d) Lost, late, incomplete, garbled, illegible, undelivered, stolen, damaged, delayed, postage-due or misdirected mail, entries, application downloads
- e) Any other errors or problems in the connection with the Contest, including, without limitation, errors that may occur in the administration of the contest, the accouchement of the winner, the cancellation or postponement of the event and/or the flyover, if applicable, the incorrect downloading of the application, the processing of the entries application downloads in any Contest related materials

Except where prohibited, each entrant agrees that any and all disputes, claims and causes of action arising out of, or connected with, the Contest or any prize awarded shall be resolved individually, without resort to any form of class action, and exclusively by the appropriate court located in Pennsylvania. All issues and questions concerning the construction, validity, interpretation and enforceability of these Official Rules, entrants rights and obligations, or the rights and obligations of the Sponsor in connection to the Contest, shall be governed by, and constructed in accordance with, the laws of Pennsylvania, without giving effect to any choice of law or conflict of law rules, which would cause the application of the laws of any jurisdiction other than Pennsylvania.
